Notes:

In addition to interventions by the mentors and intellectual hubs, Week 2 is largely dedicated to Group Presentations. The roles of the facilitator and discussant are as follows:

FACILITATOR: Provides overall leadership for the sessions

- Ensures presenters and participants stay on schedule
- Manages the Q&A session and transitions between speakers
- Encourages inclusive participation

DISCUSSANT: Focuses on the ideas and arguments presented

- Listens attentively to the presentations and offers a short 5-minute response (it is expected that at least 3 members of the discussant group will speak)
- Highlights the strengths, key insights and potential gaps in the work that warrant further reflection
- Connects the presentation to broader indigenous knowledge debates.
- Raises at least 3 key questions that will stimulate dialogue among the participants and enrich the discussion
